Dr Stamm relocated to Whangarei, New Zealand in 2016 and joined the team at Kowhai Dental in May, 2017. Dr Stamm has lectured extensively throughout Europe and Asia, and continues to be a world-renown speaker on Implantology and Restorative Dentistry.
