Course Description

This theoretical and practical course is designed for Dental Practitioners with little or no experience of implant dentistry. The course will encompass both surgical and restorative aspects of implant dentistry and provide delegates with skills and information to incorporate implants into their daily practice.

This programme will be held at the Zimmer Biomet Institute in Winterthur, Switzerland where the hands-on training will take place in our Simulated Patient Training Laboratory allowing clinicians to practice real-life case scenarios on simulation patients.

On completion of this course participants should be able to provide aspects of implant treatment in simple cases and be able to identify patients who need more advanced specialist care.

Aims & Objectives

- To understand the important aspects of patient assessment that influence clinical decision making and treatment planning in implant dentistry
- To provide an understanding of the skills necessary for safe and effective surgical implant treatment
- To provide an understanding of the skills necessary for restorative aspects of implant treatment
- To understand problems, complications and maintenance of implant treatment

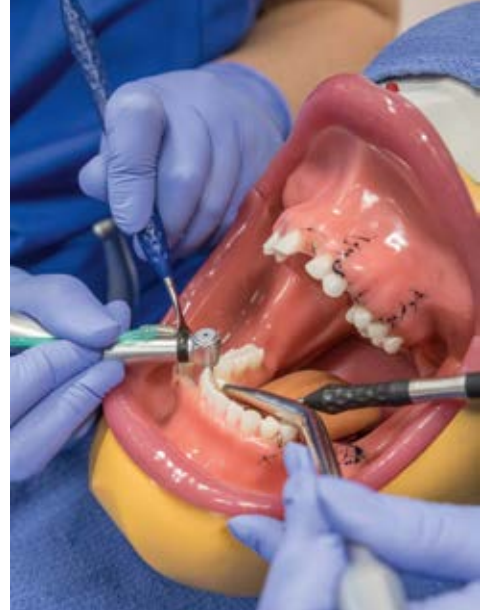
