Overdenture vs. Fixed Detachable Restorations

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION:

The clinical cases to be presented in this program will demonstrate implant-retained overdentures and compare those to fixed detachable implant-supported treatment solutions for full-arch rehabilitation. The “When, Why and How” of the decision making process will be presented describing which type of restorative option is best to meet the patient’s demands and expectations, based on a variety of clinical factors. The procedures will be presented and explained, using clinical records, radiographs, models, and photographs. The criteria for selection of materials and technologies, and alternatives, will be discussed as they are relevant to each case. At the completion of each case presentation, the clinical perspective of the treating clinician will be summarized to include: key takeaways from the treatment; a discussion of the most successful aspect of the treatment; and how the same treatment type might be performed differently.

- Illustrate the prosthodontic and laboratory procedures for design and fabrication of overdentures.
