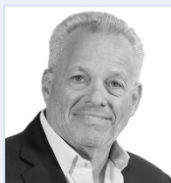
#### PROGRAM DESCRIPTION:

The clinical cases to be presented in this program will demonstrate techniques for delivering aesthetic implant-supported immediate and definitive restorations on a consistently predictable basis. With the popularity of immediate implant placement and immediate restoration, biomechanical requirements and aesthetic demands have evolved. The presentation will include treatment planning, implant site preparation, and step-by-step protocols for developing immediate implant-supported restorations in the aesthetic zone. The procedures will be presented and explained, using clinical records, radiographs, models, and photographs. The criteria for selection of materials and technologies, and alternatives, will be discussed as they are relevant to each case. At the completion of each case presentation, the clinical perspective of the treating clinician will be summarized to include: key takeaways from the treatment; a discussion of the most successful aspect of the treatment; and how the same treatment type might be performed differently.

#### PROGRAM OBJECTIVES:

At the completion of the program, participants should be able to:

- Implement new techniques for patient selection using CT scans to optimize treatment plans.
- Describe how to design and fabricate immediate provisional restorations.
- Understand the biomechanical and aesthetic considerations for achieving high primary stability for immediate implant placement and provisional restoration in the aesthetic zone.
- Describe techniques for developing ideal restoration contours that are aesthetic, hygienic, and support the soft tissue.
