

Advanced Surgical Pig Jaw Course: High Level Bone and Soft Tissue Grafting

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION:

This course is designed to acquaint the dental practitioner with current evidence-based guidelines for advanced bone and soft-tissue grafting for teeth and implants. The course will introduce important new procedures for managing and enhancing soft tissue, such as the dual-zone grafting technique and biotype-modification techniques for creating a natural emergence profile. Management of the soft tissue surgically and prosthetically while placing immediate implants will also be discussed.

- Summarize recent guidelines for immediate implant placement.
- Describe various socket anatomies, their classification and management.
- Perform GBR techniques for site development for implants, using various graft materials.
- Understand the relevance of soft-tissue biotypes in aesthetic implant dentistry.
- Preserve and develop the soft-tissue architecture around implants.
- Perform connective tissue grafts, including free gingival grafts with tunneling techniques.
- Describe the post-operative protocol and management of complications.
